II. Charges Based on Sales

- (A) 'Charges Based on Sales' shall mean the difference, if any, between the actual hire charges payable (excluding any charges for additional hours at Scale I (1)(b) and (4)(b) and any charges for miscellaneous services as listed in Scale III) as specified hereunder and the basic charges as likewise specified.
- (B) The rates with an asterisk (*) in Scale I are the basic charges only. The actual hire charges payable shall be the basic charge or 10% of the gross ticket proceeds per function, whichever is the higher.
- (C) For the purpose of calculating the gross ticket proceeds, complimentary tickets not exceeding 10 seats per function in the Lecture Hall will not be taken into account. Any quantities in excess will be regarded as tickets sold at the top price category as shown on the ticket price scale approved by the Museum.
